With a good take off you WILL make contacts out past 100km with these panels. So if you haven't got your conversion completed you still have plenty of time to get stuck in and get them going. Whilst we are interested in hearing these panels on the air we hope that all ops with whatever 3.4GHz gear will get on air and join the fun.

When? Monday 25th of April 2016 10:00am to noon AEDST
Where? Any hilltop or high ground you can find
Why? It's fun and gives everyone a chance to use their gear
Frequency? Tune 3400.100 and downwards for SSB or CW contacts
Tune 3400.200 and upwards for FM contacts
Liaison VK3RGL - 147.000 with 91.5Hz

Preparation

- Take the time to scout good operating locations in your area
- Take a hand held with you to see what repeaters you can hit
- Tell your friends and offer to take a newbie with you
- Get online and make yourself known to other interested operators
- Register your intentions to participate on [VKlogger](#) or [Contest Radar](#) to give your self the best chance of being worked. If people know you're out there they will take the time to look for you.
